Military Family Assistance

Year to date, Military Assistance Mission has met the needs of over 6,000 military members, veterans and families in the state of Arizona. Our goal is to provide for a need and bring a smile to each face.

The core objective of Military assistance Mission is meeting the emergency financial needs of families. Our primary target is active duty military members rank E1-E6 as well as veterans with combat wounds post 9/11.

In 2013 we have helped more than ninety unique needs of our men and women in uniform, wounded warriors, and their families. This year we were able to open a food pantry to meet the needs of our military families and veterans.

Our morale programs have been equally strong in 2013. In July and August MAM distributed school supplies to over 1,600 military children in Tucson, Yuma, and Phoenix to prepare them for the school year. We provided more than 4,500 tickets to military men and women for local baseball and football games, concerts, and theater performances. The annual Mighty Military Invitational brought out 60 plus participants and their families to enjoy a great day at the range. Our Holidays For Heroes Adopt a Family program matched over 40 families with sponsors to make their Christmas special. Finally Operation Holiday Open House helped almost 2,000 military members and families in Tucson and Phoenix.

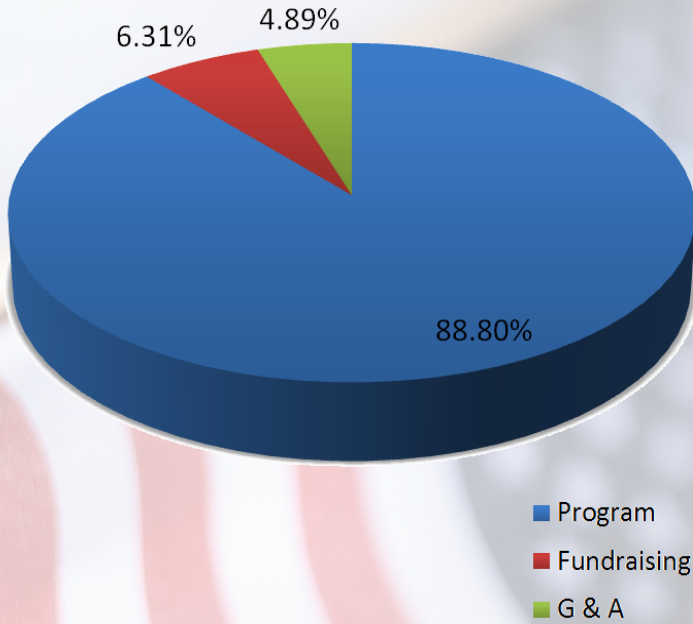

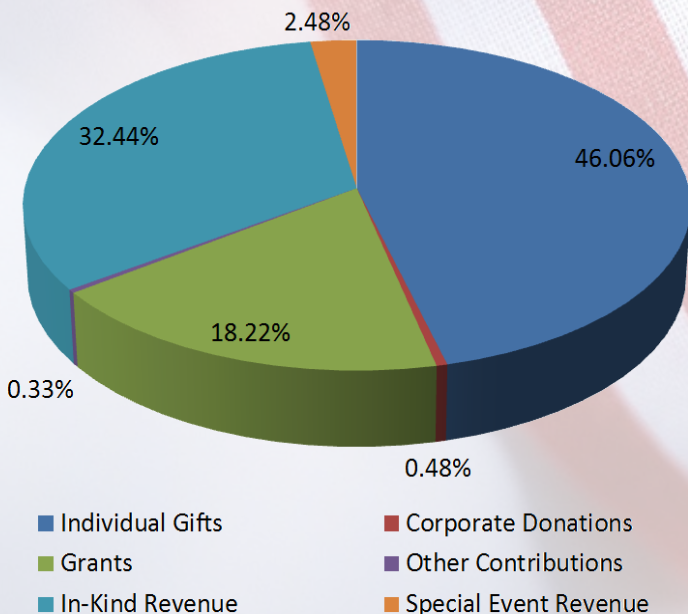
